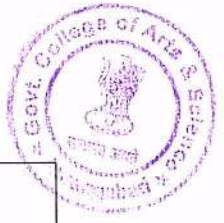

Short term and Long-Term Goals

Curriculum planning and implementation

1. Curriculum planning and delivery has been maintained at Institutional, Departmental and Individual level

Introduction of new courses

1. Proposal has submitted to Director, Higher Education Pune to start 14 PG courses
2. 3 Value added courses conducted at college level by Sociology Dept, Home science dept, Psychology dept and Music Department
3. Online certificate course conducted by Chemistry dept. History dept. and Mathematics dept.

Teaching Learning and Evaluation

1. College runs mentoring programme successfully
3. IQAC conducted one ICT based online teaching programme for all faculties in the college. All faculty members also completed online training programmes of various other agencies
4. More than 80 faculty members completed orientation and refresher courses. 25 faculty members completed training from YASHADA
5. Department of Chemistry, Zoology organized the field visits for students
6. Almost all faculties are using ICT tools for teaching and Learning

1. Number of research methodology workshop and seminar as well as gender awareness related workshop and conference has increased. National workshops on Gender sensitization sponsored by state commission for Women. (Total 3)
2. Three days National workshop on NAAC methodology on A & A in collaboration with IQAC Cluster India was organized
3. One day NAAC sponsored Online Seminar was organized by IQAC

4. National conference on Advance Materials in Research and Industries by Chemistry Dept. was organized
5. Guest Lectures on Advance trends in Microbiology Dec 21 to Jan 2022
6. Research methodology course by Sociology dept was organized It was sponsored by ICSSR
7. Under total 9 MOU's total 15 activities were completed
8. 18 Research guides are working with affiliated research centers.
9. Faculty members have published **300** research papers in the last five years

2. College purchased Gymnasium instruments under RUSA grants and developed Gymnasium for students
3. Language lab has developed with the capacity of 40 computers
