

#### Report of the national conference 'Adolescent Girls and their Health' Sponsored by State commission for women, Maharashtra (30-11-2018)

An interdisciplinary national conference on 'Adolescent Girls and their Health' was organized by the department of Home Science, Government College of Arts and Science, Aurangabad on **30<sup>th</sup> November 2018**. This conference was organized in collaboration with Maharashtra State Commission for Women. Chairperson of the Commission Vijayatai Rahatkar and Member Secretary of the Commission Dr. Manjusha Molawane extended great support and guidance for organizing this conference. The conference commenced with the lighting of the traditional lamps with the auspicious hands of the guests.

Principal Dr.Rohini Kulkarni-Pandhare felicitated the key note speaker Dr.Shobha Udipi, Director, I ntegrative Nutrition and Ayurceuticals, Medical Research Centre, Kasturba Health Society, Ville Parle, Mumbai, The Head of the department of Home Science Smt.Sanjivanee Godsay felicitated Prof.Vishala Patnam, former Principal and Head, College of Community Science, Vasantro Naik Marathwad Krishi Vidyapeeth, Parbhani, the chief guest. Dr. Anuradha Nisal, the convener Dr.Nilima Sinha, ,Retd.Head,Department of Home Economics, Vasantrao Naik Government Institute of Arts and Social Science, Nagpur resource person of the first technical session. Smt. Asha Kitke, the treasurer felicitated Dr.Smita Awacahar, Professor, department of Sociology, Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad was resource person of the second technical session. Principal and chairperson of the inaugural session Dr.Rohini Kulkarni-Pandhare was felicitated by Sanjivanee Godsay.Publisher,Ajanta Prakashan Vinay Hatlole was felicitated by the Principal.All the guests were felicitated by offering fruit basket, shawl and a momento. The guests released the copies of the proceeding of the conference.

Smt.Sanjivanee Godsay spoke about the theme of the conference.In her key note address Dr.Shobha Udipi spoke about the Adolescents in India.According to her,depression is highest in India due to desire for perfection.India also has highest rate of suicide and sexual abuse.Adolescence age is most disadvantaged,neglected,vulnerable and marginalized.The development of adolescent brain is influenced by nutrition and social environment.They also face sexual health risks due to early marriage and early pregnancy.Western patterns are now emerging in India like divorce,remarriage and change in cohabitation.The main cause of teen stress is negligient parents, high expectations in academics,absurd or deprived childhood and a demand for familial responsibilities.

After the keynote address, the Principal delivered the presidential address wherein she congratulated the department for conducting the conference and



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stressed on the importance of the topic of the seminar and its relevance in day to day life.Smt.Madhuri Thote expressed the vote of thanks.

Smt.Asha Kitke introduced Dr.Nilima Sinha, the resource person for the first technical session.Dr.Sinha spoke about the psychological issues during adolescence. She stated that self-concept is very important in shaping later life. Parents should identify disruptive behavior of the child. The sources of conflict between parents and adolescents are conflict over friends, clothes, where to go, chosen activities, changing goals, use of internet and cell phones etc. Adolescents want to be heard, communication should be positive and encouraging. Parents should be careful about judgemental words. The resource person for the second technical session was Dr.Shobha Udipi. She explained the theme 'Adolescents are second window of opportunity. According to statistics, there are 250 million adolescents in India. Malnutrition is responsible for various physical disorders like stunted growth, anemia and menorrhagia etc.Smt.Asha Kitke expressed the vote of thanks for this session.

The resource person for post lunch and third technical session was Dr.Smita Awachar.She was introduced by Dr.Archana Choudhari.The topic of her presentation was 'Adolescent girls and social envirionment'. She stated that the first environment available to child is the mother's womb,next is the school environment.But unfortunately, healthy social environment is not always found in schools, colleges and other educational institutions. This results in social immaturity. It was a brain storming session. The chief guest of the valedictory function was Prasad Mirkale, deputy CEO, Women and Child welfare department, Aurangabad municipal corporation. In his speech he shared his experiences regarding the work of the department regarding adolescents and women welfare. The guest speaker of the valedictory function was Prof. Vishala Patnam. She was introduced by Smt.Surekha Bhavsar. Dr.Vishala Patnam stated that in every body there is an enemy within. In the first fourteen years of life a blue print is prepared which shows what type of adult a child will become. She elaborately spoke about the development of adolescents with the help of many examples.After her speech Smt. Godsay gave the summary of the conference. They also congratulated the team for publishing the proceedings well in advance. The conference concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by Dr. Anuradha Nisal.

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


